What this tells us. Our students out-perform the national picture in the middle and upper bands — at A Level more of them reach A*–A and A*–B than nationally, and at GCSE nine in ten secure a standard pass, well ahead of the country. Lifting attainment at the very top grades, A* and A, is where we are focusing our teaching and intervention for 2027.

National averages are the published 2026 figures for all UK entries. GCSE grades are shown on the A*–C scale and map to the 9–1 grades used in England: A*–A to grades 7 and above, A*–C to grade 4 and above. Against England-only GCSE figures the college is 10.7 percentage points below at A*–A and 20.1 points above at A*–C. No national benchmark is published for the GCSE A*–B band.
